It's that time of year again that we are looking for qualified Brothers who are interested in serving as a Nebraska State Aerie Officer.

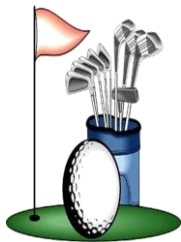
