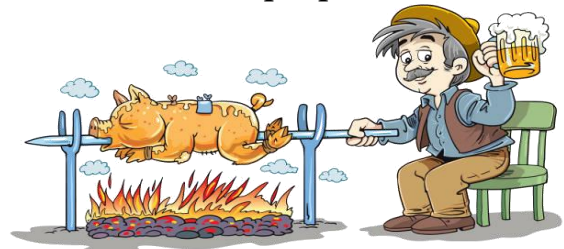

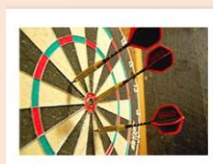

Dave Smith, Grand Worthy President, is a 40-year member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles. He joined Rossland Aerie #10 in May 1980. Rossland is an old mining town in British Columbia and is Canada's oldest Aerie, where he became Aerie President in 1982-83, also holding many other chairs in the seven years he lived there.

Smith moved to Penticton, B.C., in 1988 but learned the Aerie there had moved its charter to Summerland, B.C., a few miles away. He was asked by the then B.C. Provincial President Irv Dick to form an Aerie in Penticton, which he did in May 1991, attaining the Legion of Honor of which he is very proud. The creation of the Penticton Aerie made the Provincial Aerie a Bell Ringer Province. His hard work for the British Columbia Eagles helped make him Provincial President in 2001 and Pacific Northwest Regional President in 2007.

Brother Dave has served on many Committees and became a member of the Grand Aerie Hall of Fame in 2010 and the B.C. Provincial Hall of Fame in 2011. He believes strongly in the Ritual and its many virtues, which he says has kept him focused over the years. Brother Smith is especially proud of the Eagles motto, "People Helping People," which Penticton upholds each year by donating \$25,000+ to community organizations.
